Degree Completion for IDC's

Independent Duty Corpsmen play a significant role in provision of health care for servicemen and women and their families. Touro University International would like to join the few universities who provide opportunities to complete a BS degree in the convenience of their location with no residency requirement. The BS in Health Sciences will provide IDCs the opportunity to enhance their knowledge base to obtain the credentials to pursue advanced educational opportunities, and be eligible for promotion in the Navy. Touro University International developed a specifically tailored BS in Health Sciences-degree completion program for IDC's. The program built on the strengths of the IDC program and provides a combination of opportunities to fulfill requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences (BSHS). IDCs who complete the course work for the degree will be prepared to continue their education in any Master's program, such as a Master of Science in Health Sciences with specialization in Public Health, or Master of Science in Health Sciences with specialization in Health Care Management.

Degree Summary

The Bachelor's degree is a 124 credit program consisting of a total of 92 transferable credits, 60 credits of advanced standing (from IDC "C" school), 32 lower division general education, and 32 credits of TUI coursework.

Degree Summary

The degree is a 124-semester credit program consisting of a combination of up to 92 transferable credits of Lower Division including General Education and advanced standing (from "C" school credits) and electives. A minimum of 32 credits of coursework must be completed at TUI.
